

Safety and Health Service Regulation



#### **Article 1. General Provisions**

- **1.1.** The Security and Health Service of the "NEU National Educational University" (hereinafter referred to as the "University"), in which the doctor's office also functions, is a structural unit of the University;
- **1.2.** The Service conducts its activities in accordance with the applicable legislation, subordinate normative acts, the University's regulations, the personnel management rules and these regulations.

### Article 2. Management and functions of the Service

**2.1.** The Service has a head, a doctor and a specialist in terms of economic activities. The Service is headed by the head, the medical office is headed by a doctor, and the specialist in economic activities. The above-mentioned persons are appointed and dismissed by the Rector of the University;

#### 2.2. The tasks of the Service are:

- A. Implementation of security control over the entire perimeter of the University;
- B. Maintaining discipline in accordance with the requirements established by the University Code of Ethics and Disciplinary Responsibility Norms;
- C. Identifying students who violate the order;
- D. In case of damage to University property, investigating the fact of damage to property and submitting information about the person(s) involved in the damage to the University administration;
- E. Monitoring the processes taking place in the building using surveillance cameras in full compliance with the legislation;
- F. Implementing fire safety and having the appropriate inventory;
- G. Displaying evacuation plans for the University administrative building and their constant monitoring;
- H. Conducting information meetings with students and staff on security measures;
- I. Participating in budget formation.

#### 2.3. Functions of the Head of Service:



- A. Implements discipline in accordance with the requirements established by the University Code of Ethics and Disciplinary Responsibility Norms;
- B. Detects students who violate the order;
- C. Ensures the safety of university employees and students;
- D. Monitors the processes taking place in the building using surveillance cameras in compliance with the legislation;
- E. Monitors the property registered on the university balance sheet and cases of its damage;
- F. Ensures fire safety. For this purpose, in accordance with the instructions of specialists, places fire extinguishers in a visible place in the administrative building and is responsible for periodic checks of their suitability;
- G. Ensures the placement of an evacuation plan in a visible place in the administrative building of the university;
- H. Is obliged to conduct information meetings with students and staff on security measures;
- I. Monitors the instructions on the prohibition of smoking in the building;
- J. Implements decisions and legal acts made by the Rector;
- K. Participates in the formation of the University budget.

### 2.4. Functions of the Medical Office Doctor:

- A. Providing first aid if necessary;
- B. Providing free medical consultations and assistance in the event of the spread of certain infectious or viral diseases and for the purpose of prevention;
- C. Updating medical inventory and controlling its suitability.

## 2.5. Specialist in economic activities:

- A. Providing the University with the necessary resources;
- B. Supporting the University in various technical issues;



- C. Involvement in the repair process in case of damage to the inventory/technical equipment available at the University;
- D. Monitoring the quality of work performed by craftsmen of various directions;
- E. Determining the need for various inventory and items;
- F. Performing other tasks of the head.

# Article 3. Transitional and Final Provisions

- **3.1.** This Regulation is approved by the University Senate;
- **3.2.** This University Regulation shall enter into force upon signing;
- **3.3.** The adoption, cancellation, amendments and supplements to the Regulation shall be carried out by the Senate;
- **3.4.** This Regulation shall cease to be valid in the event of the approval of a new Regulation.
